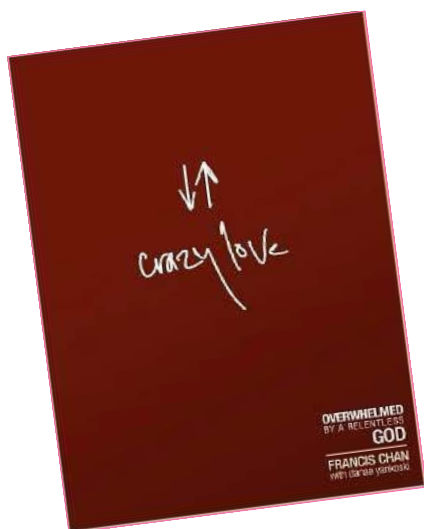
Our ministry together will require grace and mercy as mistakes will be made. Our ministry together will also see times of celebration for the victories and blessings God pours out upon us.

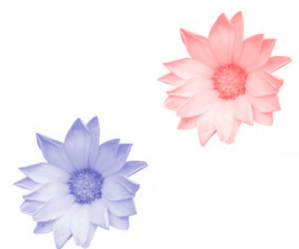
