MINISTRY NEWS

Hello Parents!

The new school year is upon us and with that the **Children's** Ministry at LSCC also enters into new classrooms, teachers,



etc. for your kids. We call the start of this "Step Up Day", and we will be stepping up the kids into their new classes beginning Sunday, September 7th. For your convenience you will see that we have laid out the classes in an easy to read map to help you know where your kids will be on Sunday mornings. We have made some rearrangements in rooms and locations to create a more child friendly and secure area. Our goal in this rearranging is to create a safe and secure kids wing for the church. Not only do the kids get a space all of their own, but parents will enjoy the convenience of being able to drop off and pick up their kids from the same place each week.

You will notice that there are two Safe-Child check in areas. This is where you will be able to check in your kids for Sunday School (9:30 a.m.) and Kids Church (11:00 a.m.). These check in areas act as a gateway to the Children's Ministry and only kids, teachers, assistants, and parents who have the check in stickers are permitted inside these Safe Kid areas. Parents will have the choice of bringing their kids to their rooms or allowing one of our friendly guides to walk your child to their room. Parents later will be allowed to either pick their kids up from their rooms or again allow a guide to bring the kids to the check in area.

At 9:30 a.m. on Sunday mornings, kids will be able to take part in a great Sunday School program geared for their ages. Bible stories, crafts, games, and friends are what they can look forward to during this time. All of the activities of Sunday School are themed to match with our 11:00a.m. Kids Church time.

At 11:00 a.m. kids meet in the BIG Gatherings for Kids Church. This is a worship service for kids with music, dramas, Bible verses, and a small group lesson that targets the ages of the kids. Kids split into small groups for their lesson and then come back together to wrap up what they've been learning all day.

Both the 9:30 a.m. Sunday School and 11:00 a.m. Kids Church are an exciting way to engage your child in the Bible and story of God. These two times work best together! The Sunday School time paves the way for the lessons of Kids Church and we encourage parents to bring kids for both the 9:30 time and 11:00 time. Kids who stay from 9:30 Sunday School to 11:00 Kids Church will be escorted from their classes into their BIG Gatherings. Parents don't need to check them in again. Parents may choose to participate in any of our Adult Sunday School classes, serve in a ministry during one of the worship services, or even catch up with friends over a cup of coffee in our lobby or in Connection Central.
