Read Mark 14:43

Why did they come for Jesus with a large crowd of men who were armed? What does this reveal about their thoughts of Jesus?

Read Mark 14:27, John 18:8, Luke 22:54-62, and John 21:15-19

Each of these verses describes a portion of the rejection Jesus experienced and a warning to the disciples. He wanted to spare Peter the temptation of rejecting Him, but Peter was stubborn and followed anyway. How does the account in John’s gospel connect with the rejection Jesus faced?

Read Mark 15:10 and Galatians 4:4-7

According to these verses, why was Jesus condemned to die?

In Mark 14:1-11, Jesus was adored (worshipped and appreciated) in an extravagant way. How might you begin to show Jesus this kind of love and devotion?

Take some time to thank God for His vast patience in dealing with the many responses we have to His love. Ask Him to help you live like His Son, with purpose and conviction to follow His will no matter the cost.
