## A Kingdom Upside Down Hypocritical Prayer and Fasting

Matthew 6:5-18

Prayer should \_\_\_\_\_ us closer to God's \_\_\_\_\_, not man.

Prayer builds an \_\_\_\_\_ with God.

### The Lords Prayer:

Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.  
Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.  
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil:  
For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

**Practice the S.O.A.P method this week with Matthew 6:5-18**

**S** = Scripture (Read through the scripture a few times.)

**O** = Observation (What are some observations that stuck out to you in this weeks scripture?)

**A** = Application (How can you apply these observations/scriptures to your life?)

**P** = Prayer (Spend time in prayer over these passages and ask God to help you apply His truth to your life.)

1. Have you known someone who pretended to be something they weren't? How did that make you feel?
2. In what ways have you pretended to be something you're not?
3. How has prayer been an important part of your relationship with God? In what ways could you develop this relationship further?
4. If our prayer time went from asking God to do things for us, to asking God what He wants for us, how might that change our lives?
