# Practice the S.O.A.P method this week with Matthew 7:13-20 and Matthew 25:31-46

- **S** = Scripture (Read through the scripture a few times.)
- **O** = Observation (What are some observations that stuck out to you in this weeks scripture?)
- **A** = Application (How can you apply these observations/scriptures to your life?)
- **P** = Prayer (Spend time in prayer over these passages and ask God to help you apply His truth to your life.)
- 1. How does the depiction of entering God's kingdom through the narrow gate, or path make you feel? Do you feel like it's possible to do? Why or why not?
